THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

The fourth of the Old Testament promises providing a Lenten baptismal lens is the promise God makes to Moses - those who look on the bronze serpent will live. When we receive the sign of the cross in baptism, the cross then becomes the sign we can look to in faith for healing, for restored relationship to God and lastly, for hope when we are dying.
