THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

A woman finds healing by touching Jesus' cloak, and a girl is restored to life when He takes her by the hand. In both cases, a boundary is crossed; in Jesus' time, the hemorrhaging woman was considered ritually unclean, polluting others by her touch; and anyone who touched a corpse also became unclean. In Mark's gospel Jesus breaks down barriers, from His first meal at a tax collector's house, to His last breath on the cross as the temple curtain is torn in two. We must dare to touch Jesus in our "uncleanness" and thus live as a community that defines no one as an outsider -- not the poor, the sick or the needy.
