THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

In today's gospel from John, there are people who take offense to Jesus' invitation to eat His flesh and drink His blood; even many of Jesus' disciples peel off and leave Him. This is the backdrop in John's gospel for Peter's confession of faith. "To whom can we go?" asks Peter. Lutherans sing the liturgical answer just before the gospel is read, "You have the words of eternal life." In order to take such a stand as Peter and Joshua (from today's Old Testament lesson) did, Paul tells us to arm ourselves with the Word of God. We pray in the Spirit that we might be bold ambassadors of the Holy Gospel.
