THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

James tells us to stop showing favoritism in the assembly by not treating the rich visitor with more honor than the poor one. In today's gospel, Jesus seems to show partiality in His first response to the Gentile woman. Was He testing her faith in saying Gentiles don't deserve the goods meant for God's children? Or was He speaking out of His human worldview, transcending those limits when she took Him by surprise with her reply? Either way, the story tells us that God shows no partiality. Everyone who brings a need to Jesus is received with equal honor as a child and heir.
